A Career Navigator is assigned to help participants find and maintain employment. An Individual Career and Financial Plan (ICFP) is developed and follow up meetings are held regularly. Career Navigators seek local employers to find jobs suitable for participants and follow up to ensure job placement satisfaction.

#### RETENTION

Career Navigators remain in contact with participants by helping them during the 90 days of employment cope with new responsibilities, resolve job issues and meet basic needs by assisting them with access to food, shelter, and vouchers for clothing/transportation, if needed.

#### UNIFORMS FOR THE FINAL SALUTE

A program designed to honor Unaccompanied Veterans who will be buried at the Coastal Bend State Veterans Cemetery in Corpus Christi, TX. Unaccompanied Veterans receive a dress military uniform from their branch of service to ensure they are buried with honor and respect for serving our country.

# **GOODWILL RUN RULES:**

#### All runners have a collective responsibility to keep the event safe!

- 8:00 am Start Time (5K Run, 10K Run, and 2 Mile Walk).
- Do not run more than two side by side.
- Do not run down the middle of the road or trail.
- Alert people when you are passing them -- "on your left/right."
- Ensure oncoming traffic yield to you before proceeding across a road. Don't assume cars will stop if you are entering a crosswalk.
- Pin your race number on the front of your shirt/shorts.
- Slower runners and walkers should move to the back of the race pack.
- If you drop something, don't stop and pick it up! Wait until almost everyone has crossed the starting line; then retrieve it.
- If you need to tie your shoe or stop, move to the side of the course.
- If you see someone in distress on the course, report their number to a course official.
- When approaching a water station, move out of the line of traffic. Do not block others or volunteers handing out water.
- Throw your used cup in the trash can/bag.
- Pay attention to your surroundings. The course may or may not be closed to traffic. It is your responsibility to watch for oncoming traffic!
- Once you have crossed the finish line, keep moving forward until the end of the finish chute.
- · Yield the right of way to all police and emergency vehicles.
- Yield the course to athletes in wheelchairs, you can change direction or stop more quickly than they can.
- If you feel you deserved an award and your name was not announced, don't run on stage to debate the award with the announcer. The announcer just reads the information given to them by the race officials. Find a race official and discuss the discrepancy with them.
- Participants will have one hour after results posting to bring up discrepancies.
- If you're registered for the 2 Mile Walk, you must walk the entire course. Running or jogging during the walk is not permitted. Participants found running or jogging will be disqualified.
